

# SFTP – Uploading data files

The following is a guide on how to **UPLOAD** large files to be sent to New Zealand Post from external clients using the **SFTP** method

1. Navigate to the **SFTP** URL <https://ecnftp.co.nz/ecnftp/> Login page should now be displayed on screen (NB: if you access the SFTP site, and the **USERNAME** field has the user name details and the **INITIAL DIRECTORY** field has **/from-post**, enter the **PASSWORD** and go directly to Step 3)

4. Click on the UPLOAD button

On the next screen, select Browse.....

To locate the file you wish to upload, once you have selected the file, click the green tick at the top of the page.

You will see the file uploading via the progression bar at the bottom of the screen (dependent on browser being used), once this is complete the file should be uploaded to SFTP

5. Once the file has been uploaded advise [datasolutions@nzpost.co.nz](mailto:datasolutions@nzpost.co.nz) that the file is available on the SFTP
